
## **SOUTH BRENT PARISH BIRD SURVEY – JANUARY 2021 RESULTS**


The South Brent Parish Bird Survey aims to monitor the birds of the parish in both winter and the breeding season, by ensuring that all 52 1-km squares are visited by at least once by one observer in January and May each year to record the species seen and heard. In 2021, 24 observers paid 180 square visits and recorded 70 species. This compares to 11 observers, 125 square visits and 67 species in 2020, when the weather was mostly wet and windy. The weather was more conducive to venturing out this January, and covid-19 restrictions probably encouraged more people to walk in the local area.


The results are shown in Appendix 1, including those for January 2021. No new species were added this year, but a single **Black-headed Gull** (at Wastewater Treatment Works, Brent Mill) and **Lapwing** (near Lincombe) were both the first in January since 2017. Most species were recorded in more squares this year than last, when many were at their lowest ebb since 2014, and one overall conclusion is that the species, and the number of squares they have been recorded in, has not changed greatly over the last eight years. This may not be a surprising conclusion, but at least we now have data to support it, and although there are few discernible trends, there have certainly been ups and downs in most species.


The data from Appendix 1 can also be represented as bar charts and four examples are shown below. Caution is needed in interpreting such data, but **Greenfinch** seems to be recovering from a 2018–20 low, **Sparrowhawk** and **Treecreeper** were recorded in the highest number of squares since the survey began, whereas for **Wren** the number of squares in January has been consistently lower in 2018–21 than in 2015–17.
